

# Overflow extension

If text cannot fit within (i.e., overflows) a fixed-size `<fo:block-container>` or `<fo:inline-container>`, the original text can be substituted with a different character string by specifying `overflow="replace"` and '[axf:overflow-replace](#)'. Also, by specifying `overflow="condense"` and '[axf:overflow-condense](#)', etc., you can condense text, reduce the character size, reduce the line spacing, etc.
