

## Text alignment in a table cell

Use the XSL 1.1 `-ah-display-align` and `vertical-align` property to align the blocks of text in a table cell to the top, bottom, or center of the cell. Antenna House Formatter has an extension: `justify` value that adjusts the space between lines so that the text fills the table cell.
