

Hanging punctuation at the start / end of line

Specifies whether punctuation at the start and/or end of a line may hang outside the line. If `axf:hanging-punctuation="none"` is specified, hanging punctuation is not applied. If `'start'` is specified, hanging punctuation is applied at the start of a line. If `text-align="right"` or `text-align="justify"` is specified together with the `'force-end'` value, then full-width punctuation that comes at the end of a line is forced to hang. The other settings are explained in this sample. See also "[axf:hanging-punctuation](#)" in the Online Manual to learn more about the corresponding punctuation.

The same behavior as `'start'` is applied only at the first line of a paragraph.

`'allow-end'`

When the target character to be hung comes at the end of a line, it isn't hung when it fits into the line, but it is hung when it does not fit into the line.

`'last'`

The same behavior as `'force-end'` is applied only at the last line of a paragraph.
