

The **overflow** property is used to determine the behavior of Formatters when the contents of an area format to a size greater than the area's defined boundaries. Antenna House has extended the value of this property to the following values.

`overflow="replace"` allows for replacement of overflowing contents, similar to how spreadsheets replace numbers too large to display in cells with "\*\*\*\*\*". The string to replace the overflow with is defined as the value of the extension element `axf:overflow-replace`.

`overflow="condense"` allows the text to be condensed according to the value of the `axf:overflow-condense` extension property.

These extended values only apply to block-container and inline-container elements.

overflow="none" (default)
