

# Text alignment in a table cell

Use the XSL 1.1 'display-align' property to align the blocks of text in a table cell to the top, bottom, or center of the cell. Antenna House Formatter has an extension '[justify](#)' value that adjusts the space between lines so that the text fills the table cell.
