

Auto-switching of layout on right/left pages

This sample shows the auto-switching of layout on odd pages and even pages. Here we explain the case of making different contents in the footer and header on right-hand pages and left-hand pages.

The text and the image in the header are left justified on the left page, and right justified on the right page. Different images are placed on the right and left pages. In the same way, page numbers and the text are right/left justified. Put the space widely on the right side of the left page, while on the right page it is placed widely on the left side.

Another area in which we expect to see a strong need for XSL is layout and PDF conversion of XML data.
