

# Drawing a diagonal border

A diagonal border can be drawn in any region where you can specify a border, such as a table cell. A diagonal border drawn with `-ah-diagonal-border-*` is a line between the before-start vertex and after-end vertex of the region, and a reverse diagonal border drawn with `-ah-reverse-diagonal-border-*` is a line between the before-end vertex and after-start vertex of the region.

## Diagonal border in <table>

Diagonal border on the cell in the first row of the first column in a table using `-ah-diagonal-border-color: black`, `-ah-diagonal-border-style: solid`, and `-ah-diagonal-border-width: 1pt`

Group \ Sales Month	January	February	March
Group A	58.4%	68.2%	92.0%
Group B	67.0%	70.7%	88.2%
Group C	87.0%	72.3%	95.2%

## Reverse diagonal border

Reverse diagonal border on an <div> which has been defined using the following CSS styling:

-ah-reverse-diagonal-border-style: solid;  
-ah-reverse-diagonal-border-width: 4pt;  
-ah-reverse-diagonal-border-color: #2222FF;
```
