

Omitting table header/footer at a column break

The XSL Specification includes `table-omit-header-at-break` and `table-omit-footer-at-break` properties for omitting the table header or table footer at a page break. However, because these properties only apply at a page break, the table header and table footer are generated when a column break occurs in a table on a multi-column region. When the extension property value '[column](#)' is specified for `table-omit-header-at-break` and `table-omit-footer-at-break`, Antenna House Formatter omits the table header and footer when splitting the table across columns but does not omit the header and footer when splitting across pages.
