## Trimming the space between full-width punctuation and full-width character

In Japanese, the space between punctuation and character in full-width can be specified by <code>-ah-punctuation-spacing</code>. The specified space is applied between the full-width closing parenthesis and opening parenthesis, between the full-width closing parenthesis and full-width non-punctuation, between the full-width non-punctuation and full-width opening parenthesis when <code>-ah-punctuation-trim</code>: <code>adjacent</code> is specified. The value can be specified by the absolute or percentage. The default value of the space to trim can be specified by <code>-ah-punctuation-spacing</code> in the option setting file. The default value of is <code>-ah-punctuation-spacing</code>: 50%.

- -ah-punctuation-trim: adjacent, without the setting of -ah-punctuation-spacing (あい「うえお」「「かきく」けこ」)
- -ah-punctuation-trim: adjacent, without the setting of -ah-punctuation-spacing: 1em (あい「うえお」「「かきく」けこ」)
- -ah-punctuation-trim: adjacent, without the setting of -ah-punctuation-spacing: 2em (あい「うえお」「「かきく」けこ」)
- -ah-punctuation-trim: adjacent, without the setting of -ah-punctuation-spacing: 0% (あい「うえお」「「かきく」けこ」)
- -ah-punctuation-trim: adjacent, without the setting of -ah-punctuation-spacing: 50% (あい「うえお」「「かきく」けこ」)
- -ah-punctuation-trim: adjacent, without the setting of -ah-punctuation-spacing: 200% (あい「うえお」「「かきく」けこ」)
