

Adding hyphenation information

It's possible to specify `axf:hyphenation-info` and add hyphenation information. If the language which cannot be hyphenated is specified, hyphenation can't be done. If a word of the same spelling is registered more than one, the most-recent registered information will be effective.

The following example shows how to specify `<fo:declarations>`

```
<fo:declarations>
  <axf:hyphenation-info language="eng"
    xmlns:axh="http://www.antennahouse.com/names/XSL/Hyphenations">
    <axh:exceptions>
      abc-defg
    </axh:exceptions>
  </axf:hyphenation-info>
</fo:declarations>
```

The hyphenation information of "abc-defg" for the word "abcdefg" is registered. The language property is indispensable. It's also possible to specify the external exception dictionary as `src="en-add.xml"`.
