

Overflow

The overflow property is used to determine the behavior of the Formatter when the contents of an area format to a size greater than the area's defined boundaries. Antenna House has extended the value of this property to the following values: **overflow: replace**; allows for replacement of overflowing contents, similar to how spreadsheets replace numbers too large to display in cells with "*****". The string to replace the overflow with is defined as the value of the extension element **-ah-overflow-replace**. **overflow: condense**; allows the text to be condensed according to the value of the **-ah-overflow-condense** extension property. These extended values only apply to block-container and inline-container elements.

overflow: replace (default)
