

The **table-omit-header-at-break** and **table-omit-footer-at-break** properties are used to prevent a table header or footer from appearing after a table breaks across a page but allow the header or footer to appear when the table breaks across a column.

These properties have been extended to allow for a value of "column". This value will omit the header or footer when the table breaks across a column but not when it breaks across a page.

The following table has the properties `table-omit-header-at-break="column"` and `table-omit-footer-at-break="column"` in the table element.
