

Line numbers except for continued lines

When adding line numbers, line numbers are usually given for each line, but by specifying `-ah-line-number-except-continued-line`, you can add a line number only to the first line when a long line wraps. At this time, the continued line is not counted in the number of lines. This feature is available with Antenna House Formatter V7.1 and later.
