Antenna House Formatter can embed one or more pages from an external PDF file using `<fo:external-graphic>`. Fillable PDF forms can also be embedded. A PDF is embedded at its original size. Use 'content-height' or 'content-width' to scale the image if necessary. A page from a PDF file can also be used as a background image, including as the background of an `<fo:simple-page-master>` or `<fo:page-sequence>`. For more details, see [PDF Embedding](#) in the Manual.
