

Hyphenation processing of words that consist of uppercase letters

You can specify whether to hyphenate uppercase words with `'axf:hyphenate-caps-word'`. The setting is effective when `hyphenate="true"` is specified. Even small-caps processed characters are considered lowercase if the original characters are lowercase. The setting of `axf:hyphenate-caps-word="false-all"` is available from Antenna House Formatter V7.2.

If you specify `axf:hyphenate-caps-word="true"` (default), normal hyphenation is performed. Words are hyphenated regardless of whether they are uppercase or lowercase.

If you specify `axf:hyphenate-caps-word="false"`, words that are all uppercase will not be hyphenated. Words that are not all uppercase, such as words that have only the first letter capitalized, are hyphenated.

If you specify `axf:hyphenate-caps-word="false-all"`, all words with only the first letter capitalized do not hyphenate at all.

A string like ANTENNA-HOUSE with a hyphen is considered multiple words. Therefore, there is a possibility of line breaking at the hyphen position.
