Trimming the space between full-width punctuation and full-width character

In Japanese, the space between punctuation and character in full-width can be specified by 'axf:punctuation-spacing'. The specified space is applied between the full-width closing parenthesis and opening parenthesis, between the full-width non-punctuation and full-width opening parenthesis when axf:punctuation-trim="adjacent" is specified. The value can be specified by the absolute or percentage. The default value of the space to trim can be specified by 'punctuation-spacing' in the option setting file. The default value of 'punctuation-spacing' is 50%.
