

Trimming the space between full-width punctuation and full-width character

In Japanese, the space between punctuation and character in full-width can be specified by '[axf:punctuation-spacing](#)'. The specified space is applied between the full-width closing parenthesis and opening parenthesis, between the full-width closing parenthesis and full-width non-punctuation, between the full-width non-punctuation and full-width opening parenthesis when `axf:punctuation-trim="adjacent"` is specified. The value can be specified by the absolute or percentage. The default value of the space to trim can be specified by '`punctuation-spacing`' in the option setting file. The default value of '`punctuation-spacing`' is 50%.
