

Unbreakable words

List the unbreakable words in the content of the `'unbreakable-words'` element of the option setting file, using line feed as a delimiter. It is possible to list strings containing spaces and words containing hyphens. The leading and trailing white spaces (U+0009, U+0020) will be discarded. Consecutive white spaces (U+0009, U+0020) are grouped together. See `'unbreakable-words'` for details. This feature is available in Antenna House Formatter V7.0 or later.

Example of option setting file:

With Antenna House Formatter V7.0 and later, yellow background words are listed in `'unbreakable-words'` in the Option Setting File, and you can see the result by formatting this FO.
