

Hyphenation processing and SOFT HYPHEN

SOFT HYPHEN (U+00AD) is used to arbitrarily specify the position of the hyphen in the word. If hyphenation does not occur, SOFT HYPHEN does not affect the display result. You can extend [‘hyphenate’](#) to specify whether to hyphenate by SOFT HYPHEN. The setting of `hyphenate="none"` is available from AH Formatter V7.2.

If `hyphenate="true"` is specified, normal hyphenation will occur. Hyphenation by dictionary and hyphenation by SOFT HYPHEN are performed.

If `hyphenate="false"` (default) is specified, hyphenation by the dictionary is not performed, but hyphenation by SOFT HYPHEN is performed.
