

## Page master for second page

With `page-position="second"`, you can select a separate page master for the second page of a page sequence (the page after the page that matches 'first'). See '[page-position](#)' in the the Online Manual for details. This feature is available with Antenna House Formatter V7.3 or later.

In this sample, the second page is set to select a page master with a background color of "beige".

This is the second page.

By combining page-position="second" and odd-or-even="odd-document/even-document", the even or odd pages condition is added.

In this sample, a page master with a background color of "beige" is selected for a second page that is an odd-numbered page counting from the beginning of the document, and a page master with a background color of "pink" is selected for a second page that is an even-numbered page counting from the beginning of the document.
